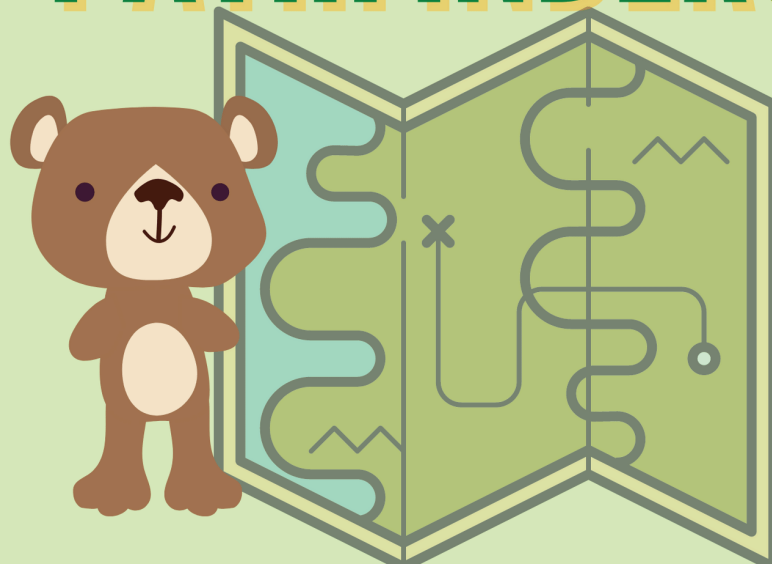

The **Pathfinders Classroom** is our Pre-K Program aimed at children between four and five years of age who'll attend Kindergarten the following year.

Here your child will be asked to complete more concrete tasks to ensure they're prepared for the next step in their education. Our goal is to ensure your child has mastered all the necessary skills to enter Kindergarten by providing individual planning, challenging your child, and considering their progress.

Pre-K children in the Pathfinders Classroom will:

- strengthen math, science, writing, reading, arts and physical skills through differentiation and small group activities
- practice social and emotional awareness like regulating emotions, responding appropriately to situations, problem-solving with peers, etc.
- work on key Kindergarten-required skills toward mastery
- enjoy positive interactions with peers, strengthening social skills in a welcoming environment

Learning Moments: understands right from wrong, uses bathroom independently, plays with peers in a positive way, identifies main colors, takes turns when playing a game, separates easily from adults, follows multi-step instructions, speaks in complete sentences understandably, walks up- and downstairs, runs, and jumps on one or both feet.

Pathfinder Families will experience their children's eagerness to learn and witness the beginning steps of readying for elementary school. Children will enjoy a perfect balance of peer socialization/interaction time and learning/kindergarten prep.

Pathfinder Classrooms are bright, fun spaces where children feel welcomed and are excited to learn. Each room contains multiple academic centers to support learning throughout the day; play-based areas for drama, art, blocks, and more; and an alphabet, number line, and word wall for easy learning and reference.
